

PLAN CAR LINES TO ALLOTMENTS

Cleveland Heights Realty Interests Consider Building Two Systems.

Gasoline or Electric Cars May be Adopted on Them.

A huge real estate improvement transaction, which will include a new street car line, is now in progress in Cleveland Heights. The deal will involve the expenditure of about \$100,000 in constructing boulevards, pavements, sidewalks and a sewer system through a great section of Cleveland Heights village, bounded by Cedar-rd, Euclid Heights boulevard, Coventry-rd and Lee-rd.

This territory will be made into a residence district, and for a mile on Washington boulevard a new street car line will be constructed. This line will connect with the Cleveland Railway Co's. tracks.

The officers of the realty company make no announcement of the kind of line they will establish, but they are known to be considering two projects. One would involve the use of storage battery cars; the other, the use of gasoline cars. Gasoline propelled street cars are now in use in southern Ohio and in other parts of the country; in Ohio the gasoline street car has assumed nearly the size of a railroad passenger coach, and is capable of extreme speed.

The Tillotson & Wolcott Co., Cleveland bond house, has purchased \$225,000 of the Cleveland Heights Realty Co's. bonds, proceeds of which will be devoted to the new project.

Another new car line is being projected through the territory, lying south of the Shaker lakes. In this second project a number of realty companies are interested. To give adequate street car facilities to this whole territory, the second new car line is being projected. It will be a mile, or a mile and one-half in length, and will probably give an initial service of fifteen minutes. When the revenue is sufficient to make the system self-sustaining, it will probably be surrendered to the Cleveland Railway Co., which will hereafter operate it as part of its system.
